Let's Get Started!

Three different kinds of online materials are offered on Classzone. The two kinds of online materials are:

Free Access: Access to correlating book specific resources that do not require registration or an order.

 Accesses to these online materials are publicly available and do not require a username/password (authentication) or license (authorization). Much of the content inside ClassZone is Free Access.

Examples: ClassZone's learning centers including animations, quizzes, and links.

Registration Access: Access to correlating book specific teacher resources that do not require an order.

 Access to these online materials is publicly available, but requires a username/password (authentication). Registration is required either to verify that a user is a teacher (by entering a code from the Teacher's Edition) or because the online material has the ability to save the user's work.

Examples: ActivityMaker, Teacher Toolkit.





Premium Activation and Registration: Access to the Online Student Book and Essay Smart

- Activation codes are e-mailed directly to the designated account(s) selected at the time of purchase. If you think there has been a problem with your order, please contact Customer Service.
- The activation code is for both teacher and student use and can be used over and over until the quantity associated with the order has been used. For example, a teacher could write the activation code on the board for her students or email it to them. We do not recommend posting the activation code on a public site.
- Only student registrations count toward the order quantity tally.
- The activation code only needs to be used the first time a student or teacher tries to access the Online Book. After creating a username and password at initial activation, you can simply sign in with their username when prompted.
- There is no need for rostering or setting up classes. You can simply
 pass out the code for the appropriate online textbook to your
 students.










3. If you already have an existing account, then choose the Activate More Products link from the My Account page.



Teacher Registration

- A teacher account also gives teachers access to some teacher only materials on ClassZone.
- To create a teacher's account, the Teacher Access Code from the front of the Teacher's Edition must also be entered when





registering. This is to verify that the registering user is a teacher.

- A confirmation email will be sent out after registration. This email will contain your chosen username and password and information about using ClassZone.
- All teachers can view the number of licenses in use and when they expire from within the My Account page.
- Teachers whose email address is associated with the order (Super Teachers) can also see a list of all registrants using a particular activation code and have the ability to remove users from the licenses when students transfer out or register more than once. You can also see when a student last signed in to use their account.
- The resources available online are only the Students edition.

Student Registration

- Students will also register by entering the activation code. Once you have received the Activation Code from your teacher, you can register using any of the following three methods.
