

Step 1

Step 2

Click **SAVE & ASSIGN ANOTHER** if you need to create assignments for schools not included in the first assignment, or click **SAVE** if you are done creating the assignments.

Did You Know?

The typical, on-grade test level appears in the middle column of the grid. This is the level that will be typically selected. You may also select up to two off-grade levels above or below the on-grade level. Assigning off-grade test levels with standards-based adaptive assessments, such as the Continuum Benchmark Assessments, is not a typical practice; however, it is permissible. The adaptive testing algorithm will expose content from one grade level up to higher-achieving students. Likewise, lower-achieving students will be exposed to content from one grade level down.
